

# Smart Shipper corrugated box usage.



Our specially designed corrugated box provides protection from scuffs during shipment, provides for labeling areas (both shipping and hazardous materials) and an automatic return label.



Assembly...

- 1) Tape the bottom of the box...



- 2) Place the Smart Shipper into corrugated...
- 3) Make sure product and coolant is

secured properly inside. Pack in such a way that as coolant sublimates, or thaws product remains secure.

***Net weight of product AND coolant not to exceed 20 lbs.***



- 4) Be sure latch pins are latched.
- 5) Add nylon wire tie for tamper resistance.

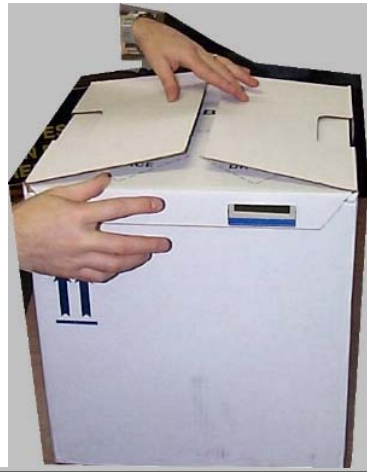
- 6) Initiate the computer to monitor the shipment...



- 7) Tuck the return flap into box...



- 8) Place return label on return flap in designated area...



9) Fold in side flaps...



10) Peel self sealing tape from "outbound" lid...



11) Press "outbound" lid firmly to affix.

12) Add tape for additional strength as needed...



13) Place ship to label in designated area.

14) Add dry ice and hazardous material labels as required per contents...



Note: All four sides of the corrugated have large blank areas for the addition of labels, or to be printed with your company logo, etc.

### Cleaning:

If there is a leak the shipper *must* be cleaned. Use a cloth damp with appropriate cleaning solution to neutralize any contamination.
